ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- The 'Application Form' for admission can be obtained from the college office on working day from 10.30 A.M. - 4.00 P.M. on or before 15th July, 2023.
- Form must be filled in applicant's own hand writing
- Applicant must paste their recent color photograph in the appropriate place. Do not staple or pin the photograph.
- Square boxes provided in application form are only for writing the alphabets in capitals letters
- Any discrepancy in the statement and / or submission of incomplete form will lead to rejection of application/cancellation of admission.
- The duly filled application form along with self attested photocopies of all required documents will be submitted in the college office on or before 18th July, 2023.
- The merit list of admission will be declared on 20th July, 2023. The merit list may be seen on college website - www.mgpgc.ac.in or college notice board.
- There will be counselling for admission and only listed candidates according to merit will be called for counselling. Their number will depend upon the number of seats sanctioned for admission. The different combination of subjects will be allotted to candidates according to their choice, merit and availability of vacant seat of that subject combination.

Facilities and Scheme for Students
