Prof. Nikhil Kumar confirmed that there is provision for giving such incentive in NAAC guidelines. Director, IQAC Prof. Namita Kumar welcomed all. She read out the minutes of the last meeting. Principal and Chairman, IQAC Prof. Anil Kumar Singh took the feed back about the status of courses completed for mid term examinations. All the member-In-charges confirmed that courses are up-to-date.

It was discussed that Internal Evaluation should be done twice every year. The mode of evaluation can be optional whether online or offline but in the Class rooms.

Dr. Namita Kumar said departments should focus on encouraging the P.G. Students for participating in seminars/conferences and various academic activities held not only at College but in different Universities/Institutions. As Dr. Shailendra Kumar, Asstt. Prof. Zoology had persuaded and two students were selected for poster presentation competition at an International Seminar at Delhi.

Prof. U.K. Gupta informed that tickets and sleeper class tickets should be produced by students. Prof. Awnish suggested, Budget allocation for seminars may be made. Principal Sir informed that requirement of Budget should be raised in this regard and send to Manager, no such funds are available.

Prof. A.N. Thakur said that in College Welfare Fund, Society Fund can be adjusted. Principal asserted that it is necessary for quality education. Prof. Alok Kumar Srivastava said that earlier Rs. 150/- were included with exam. fee. It was decided that a proposal should be sent to Manager, in this regard.

Discussing about mid term exam. syllabus Dr. Subhash Sharma stated that for paper setting a short notice is given. Principal instructed hat producing he soft an hard copies of all the activities should be provided to website In-Charge, IQAC an office without any delay.
